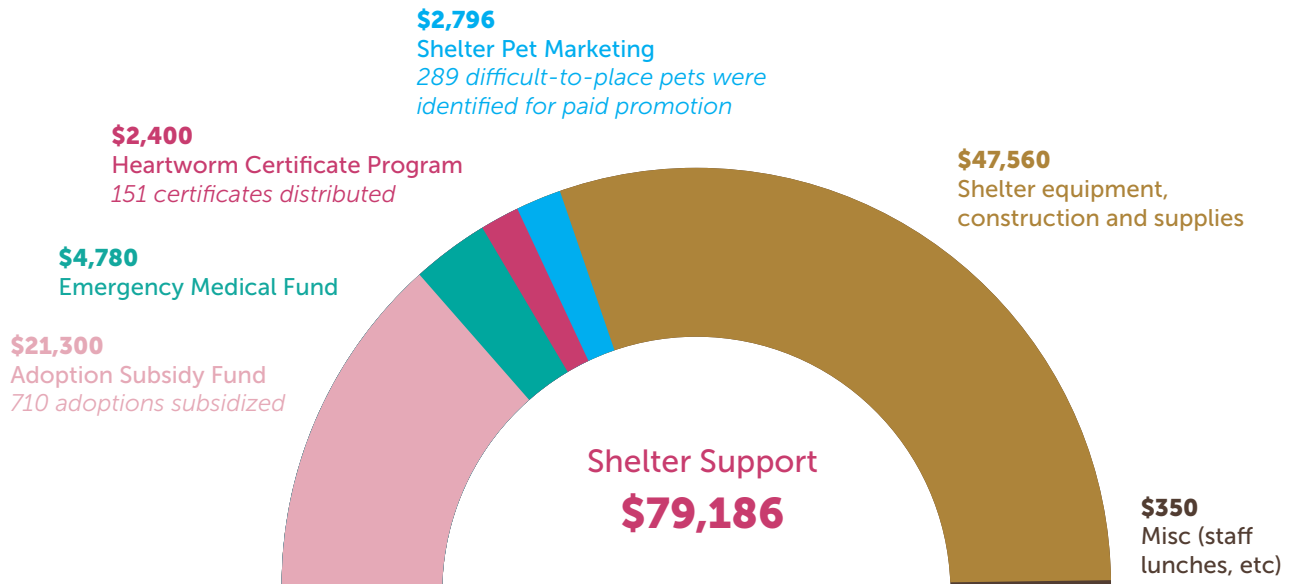


Candy before surgery

\$3,258,556

Total Support

Includes capital campaign of \$2.2 million for the new shelter, plus all other funds raised for the shelter, community, and education.

\$2,716,586

Total Shelter Support

DASF funds donated to the shelter for construction, equipment, adoption subsidies, pet medical care, supplies, and more.

\$188,110

Total Community Impact

Includes free rabies and low cost vaccine clinics, emergency food & supplies, spay/neuter grants, emergency pet medical assistance, K9 police officer kevlar vests, and more. Total pets impacted cannot ever be calculated, as grants to partners like Our Daily Bread and SPAN Meals on Wheels help many pets and owners. Approximately 4,898 pets are known to have benefitted.

Total pets saved: 14,051

Shelter Support: Linda McNatt Animal Care & Adoption Center

From July 2018 through June 2019, the shelter has handled 5,152 abandoned pets: 2,039 cats and 2,864 dogs. In addition, the shelter handled 249 livestock, wildlife and exotic animals. All adoptable dogs and cats found homes through shelter adoption, rescue groups, or reunite with their owners.

DASF continues to raise funds to support shelter pets, including through the Adoption Subsidy Fund, the Emergency Medical Fund, the Shelter Endowment Fund, Heartworm Treatment Vouchers and special projects (pet equipment, furnishings, etc). From July 2018 through June 2019, \$79,186 was granted to the shelter.

Endowment Fund Continues to Grow

Initiated in 2016 by Dr. Jerry and Shirley Watson, the **DASF Shelter Endowment Fund** increased 57% since June 2018.

DASF is making huge strides in saving homeless animals in our community, but thousands more animals still need our help. The endowment fund, which will support shelter pets in perpetuity, continues to grow. The fund has reached \$409,200 in cash and pledges. Interest on the safely invested funds may be dispersed to the shelter for adoption subsidies or special needs. The Endowment Committee oversees the fund and is composed of both DASF Board and non-Board members.

Donations to the endowment fund have been received from individuals, corporations, and wills/estates. By including DASF in your estate plans, you can help us save lives and transform countless others for years to come.

An honor plaque acknowledging endowment donors of \$2,500+ is installed in the shelter. All donations are gratefully accepted. Every gift to the endowment fund is a legacy of love and commitment to saving shelter pets!
