We've been there for animals and the people who love them because you've been there for us.

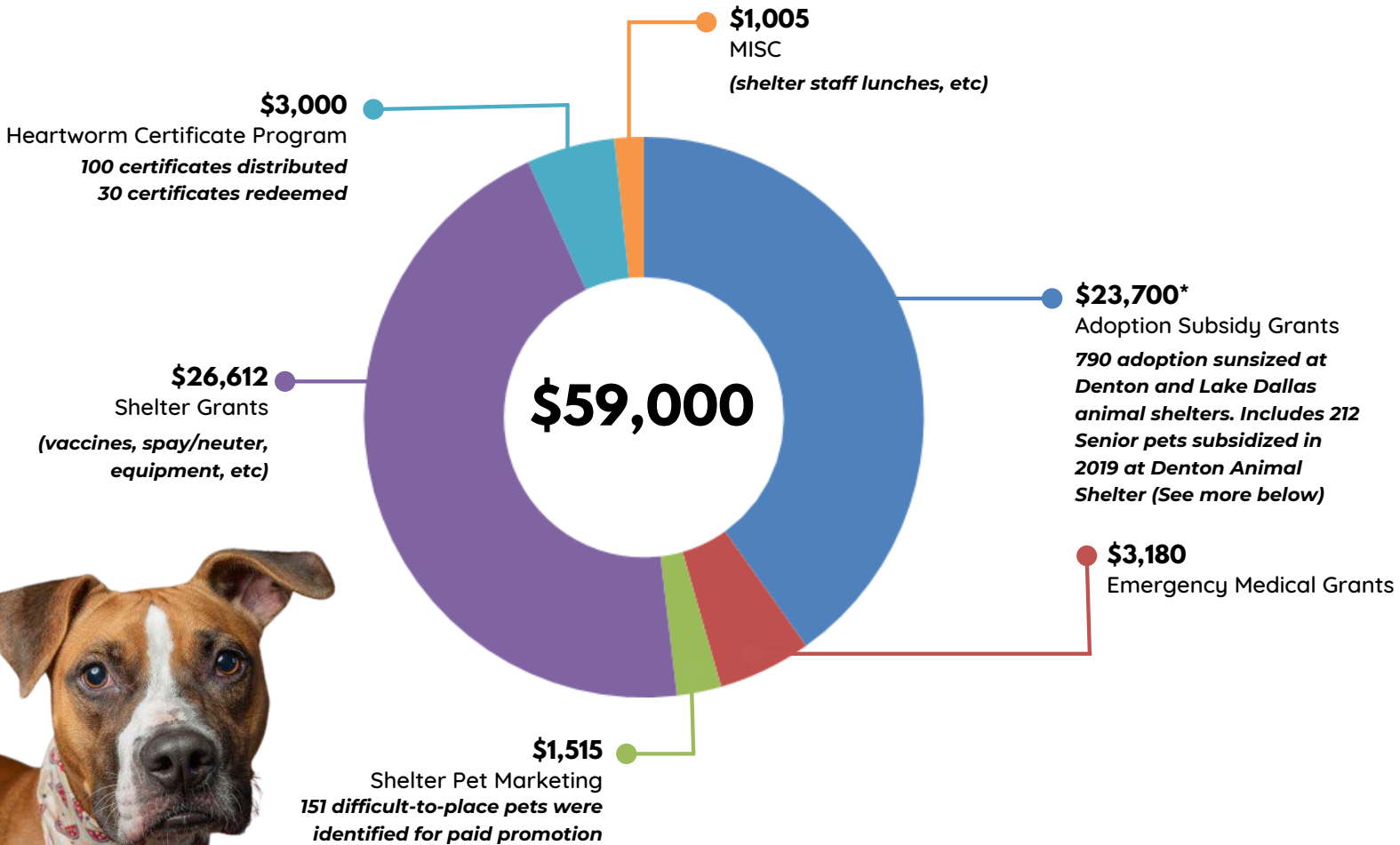

2019-2020 Shelter Financial Support

Growth in both the human and pet populations in the Denton area has increased the number of pets entering both Denton Animal Shelter and Lake Dallas Animal Shelter. The support DASF provides can be crucial to continue a high live exit rate of the municipal shelters.



*Includes subsidies for ½ price adoption events, long term pets, senior pets, heartworm positive dogs and as of December 2019, DASF is now subsidizing adoptions for all FIV+ cats and kittens.

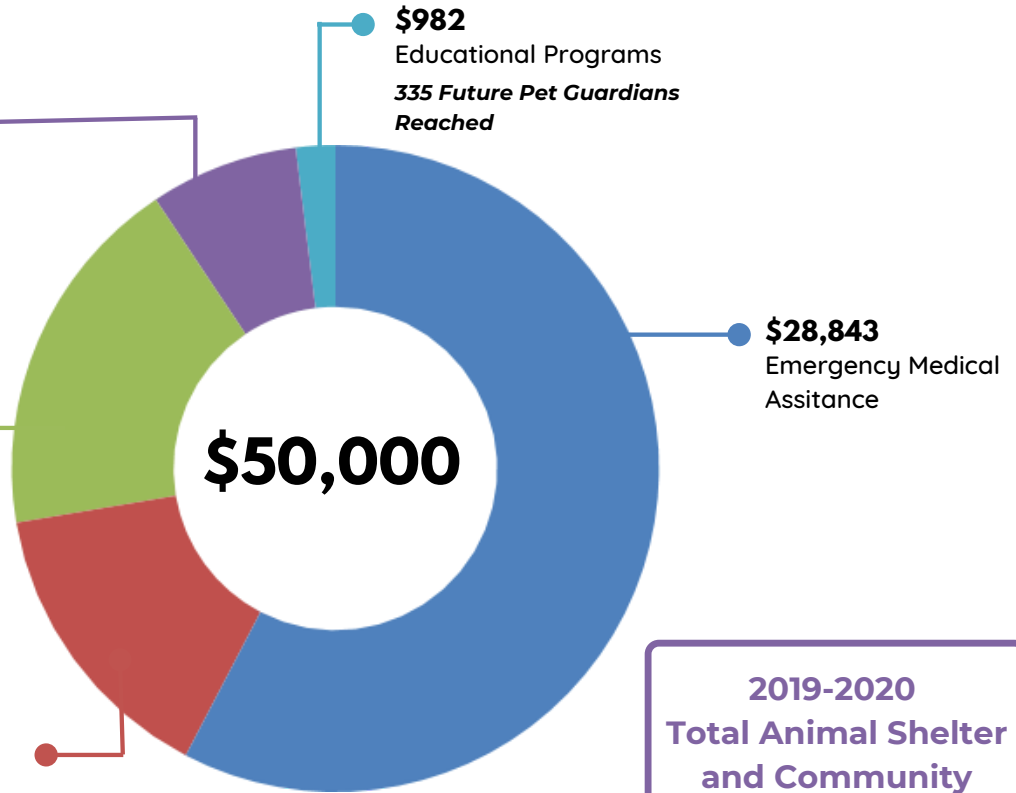

The Denton Animal Shelter has a 91% live release rate this year. This is a vast improvement from 2007 LRR of 47.7%. Adoption subsidies continue to help Denton Animal Shelter increase adoptions

2019-2020 Community Financial Support

Community initiatives focus on making pet ownership more affordable, reducing pet abandonment and overpopulation, reaching underserved communities, as well as emergency food assistance.

At the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, Denton Animal Support Foundation and the City of Denton Animal Shelter set up an Emergency Pet Food Pantry at the Linda McNatt Animal Care and Adoption Center for those facing income insecurity.

The pantry has also received generous donations from Linda & Jim McNatt, Denton Veterinary Center, Hills Science Diet, Denton Humane Society and Chana & Andy Shelton as well as the Denton community.

“Thank you to Denton Animal Support Foundation for all your work with the Denton shelter. The 82% reduction in owner surrenders is attributed by shelter management primarily to the Emergency Pet Food Pantry sponsored by DASF as well as the pet medical assistance.” - The Honorable Chris Watts, Mayor

Since 2006, DASF has saved or improved the lives of Denton area pets. Here's how:

\$3,367,600

Total Support

Includes capital campaign of \$2.2 million for the new Denton shelter, plus all other funds raised for the Denton and Lake Dallas shelters, communities, and education.

\$2,775,598

Total Shelter Support

DASF funds donated to the Denton and Lake Dallas shelters for construction, equipment, adoption subsidies, pet medical care, supplies, and more.

\$591,702

Total Community Support

Includes free rabies and low cost vaccine clinics, emergency food & supplies, spay/neuter grants, emergency pet medical assistance, K9 police officer kevlar vests, and more.

Total pets impacted - 25,445

Total pets impacted by capital purchases & programs are estimated annually (i.e. veterinary equipment, emergency food programs, etc).

Total Future Pet Guardians reached - 5,488





Year In Review

Celebrating 5 Years at the Linda McNatt Animal Care and Adoption Center



DASF is proud to have raised **\$2.2 million** toward the construction and equipping of the new 15,000 square foot City of Denton animal shelter. The City of Denton matched the DASF donation with over **\$3 million** plus the land to create a state-of-the-art shelter. We said we could do it - and WE DID!

The Linda McNatt Animal Care and Adoption Center represents a major accomplishment for DASF, as an advocate and funder of the project. The foundation was a major force in the initiation and implementation of the project, through the public-private legal partnership formed between DASF and the City.



Since opening in January 2015, over **26,000** dogs and cats have been compassionately handled in the Denton Animal Shelter. Approximately 90% of these pets have been adopted or returned to owners. In the past couple of years, all adoptable pets have been saved. Over the past 5 years, DASF has contributed over **\$450,000** in additional funds to the shelter for programs, equipment and general support. The shelter now handles 5,400 pets annually. DASF is committed to helping the City of Denton Animal Shelter remain the best in North Texas so that the pets receive high quality care and extensive opportunities for loving homes

These donations were disbursed to needy pet owners and to the shelter to aid at-risk pets.

Holiday Appeal - raised almost \$19,000. Long-time generous supporters, **Marta & Frank Dudowicz**, donated \$5,000 to the DASF Shelter Endowment Fund which matched donations received during the holiday. The year-end appeal provides a last opportunity for tax deductions to aid pets in need.

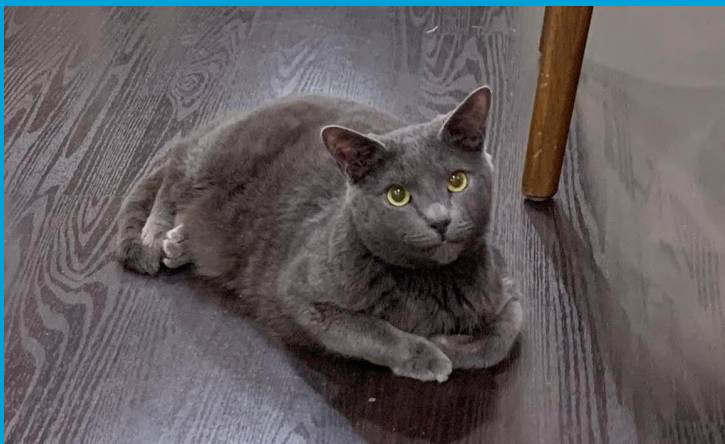


GREAT NEWS! DASF is excited to announce the shelter endowment fund has reached **\$500,000** in 2020, which was a strategic goal for DASF. Thank you to all donors for your far-sighted generosity. When you give to Denton Animal Support Foundation, you help us make a real difference in our community. The fund will provide support for the shelter pets in perpetuity.

The Endowment Committee, which is comprised of both DASF board members and non-board member stakeholders made the decision to engage professional financial management of the funds similar to most charitable foundations' handling of these types of funds. This decision insures long term growth with very moderate risk. This means that funds will be available for grants to the shelter annually in perpetuity.

Cultivar Capital, Inc., a local Denton financial consultant firm, was selected based on their experience with nonprofits and especially endowment funds ranging from school districts to small foundations. President and CEO Thomas E. Muir, CPA, CFP was highly recommended by the DASF accountants, Anderson Spector. We are excited to partner with these professionals on behalf of the animals.

Leo was adopted from the Denton animal shelter in 2017 and two years later he was diagnosed with a severe case of stomatitis - a painful inflammation of mouth & gums - making it extremely difficult to eat. Due to a hyper immune reaction to his own plaque and the severity of the inflammation of Leo's gums, the veterinary specialist recommended a full dental extraction. DASF donated towards the surgery and raised additional funds to cover the cost of surgery.

Snow White (renamed Zoey) is a shelter puppy who has had a rough time medically. After many tests, she was diagnosed with a serious heart issue requiring critical surgery. DASF was able to donate funds to match other donations covering all the tests (\$1,500). Gayla Nelsen at the Denton shelter arranged the surgery with Texas A & M Veterinary School where an updated heart procedure (less risky) was performed on June 9. DASF raised an additional \$4,000 for the surgery and follow-up care. Zoey is doing great after surgery!

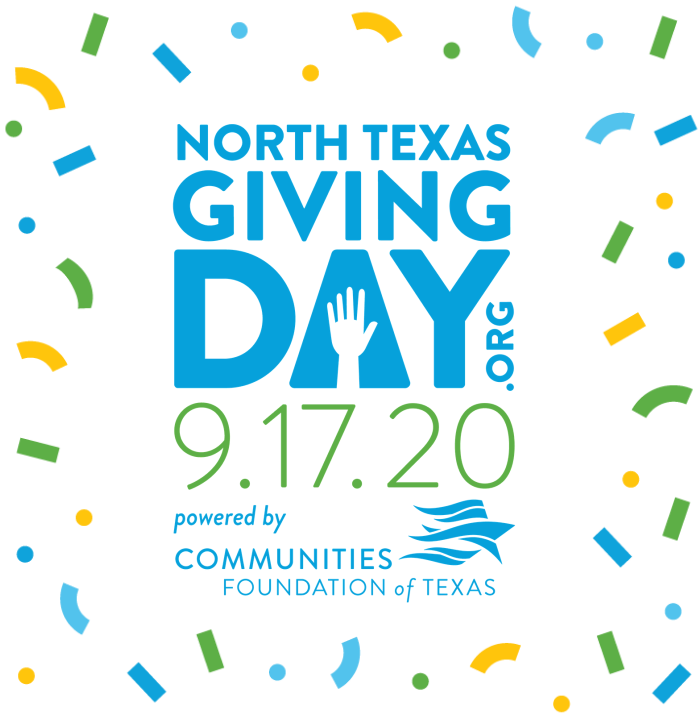
